



The AV Warehouse Handling Checklist

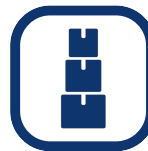
i Use this quick checklist to identify where your warehouse might be putting your gear, your team and your margins at risk.



Mezzanine & Multi-Level Storage

- ☐ Are you manually carrying gear up/down stairs?
- ☐ Are forklifts operating near fragile or high-value equipment?
- ☐ Do you have a safe, non-licensed lifting method for moving kit between floors?
- ☐ Can your current solution handle large flight cases or LED panels?

Recommendation: Consider a mezzanine goods lift with anti-slip flooring and soft-stop movement



Prep & Packing Areas

- ☐ Are staff bending, twisting or lifting from the floor?
- ☐ Is gear being stacked or positioned at awkward heights for handling?
- ☐ Do you rely on multiple people for basic loading/prep tasks?
- ☐ Are there delays in loading due to manual processes?

Recommendation: Use a mobile scissor lift table to set your ideal working height and reduce strain.



Rack & Floor-Level Access

- ☐ Do you need to pull gear from shelves or pallets?
- ☐ Is fragile kit being handled in tight space?
- ☐ Are you working with a mix or heavy and awkward loads?
- ☐ Do you have a solution that works without needing a license?

Recommendation: Pronomic stackers offer compact, precise lifting for racks and confined areas.



Crew Safety & Workflow

- ☐ Have you had any near-misses or injuries due to lifting?
- ☐ Are safety features (like overload sensors and interlocked gates) built into your lifting process?

Recommendation: Speak to an expert, Discuss the perfect solution for you and your team.
